



Zone A Resident Placard Instructions

- Neighborhood protection barricades will be put in place approximately four hours prior to large-scale stadium events and removed approximately 2 hours after they end.
- Please display your placard on your vehicle's rearview mirror during stadium and special events, when temporary barricades and/or area traffic restrictions are erected in your neighborhood. **The placards issued to you last year can be used this season.**
- **Please be prepared to stop at the barricade** and allow the person staffing the barricade to see the placard before you enter the neighborhood.
- Traffic barricade locations are listed the enclosed maps. The Zone A hotline will be available the day before and the day of an event. Call 623-930-3214 to speak to a staff person for updates or questions, or visit www.GlendaleGotGame.com If you lose and/or need additional placards, please call 623-930-3686.
- In the event you forget or lose your placard during an event, you will be asked to show the barricade attendant proof of residency. Your driver's license will be the most convenient form of identification.
- Vehicle placards can only be used for entrance into your neighborhood. They cannot be used for access into any pre-determined parking areas related to Glendale stadium events and/or Glendale arena events. Placards are being distributed by street address and are not transferable. Please do not give your placard to anyone not residing at your address.

Zone A Instructions for Guests/Visitors

- Placards will not be issued to visitors or guests. ***If you expect visitors on an event day, please contact the Zone A Resource Line at 623-930-3686 prior to the event.*** Please follow the recorded instructions.
- A "visitors list" will be used by the Glendale Police to permit entrance by your guest(s), to your residence. You may also enter your visitor` information online, by visiting: www.GlendaleGotGame.com.
- Please ask your guests to use the following designated entry sites for your neighborhood (doing so will ensure convenient access into your neighborhood):
 - If you live in Rovey Farm Estates, the guest entrance will be located at 83rd and Emil Rovey Parkway.
 - If you live in the Desert Mirage Area, the guest entrance will be located at 83rd and Maryland Avenues.
 - If you live in Pendergast Estates, the guest entrance will be located at 91st and Marshall Avenues.
